**Men's Race volunteers:** trade with Junior Race volunteers and return gear to Race HQ by 1:00 pm.

**Women's Race volunteers:** pick up gear at HQ between 1:00 and 1:30 pm. Return gear by 5:30 pm.

### Road & Intersection Volunteer Stations

**#1-8** along Fourth Ave and Jefferson

\*NO vehicles, except for emergency vehicles, are allowed on Race Route during races. Consider the safety of crowd when allowing cross-traffic.

\*Alert crowd to approaching runners.

\*Keep crowd out of the street during the races.

\*Watch for runners during parade and make sure they have safe access to route.

**#9, #10, #11, #12** evenly spaced along Lowell Canyon Dr between First Ave and gate in Canyon: in addition to the above, direct spectators to move out of road, preferably to south side of road.

### Lowell Canyon Volunteer Stations

**#13, #14** bottom of berm area: Alert spectators to approaching runners.

Keep the trail clear.

**#15, #16** along crowd barrier: Maintain crowd barrier. Do not allow any unauthorized people behind barrier.

**#17, #18** above crowd barrier: Alert spectators to runners using Switchback Trail and maintain crowd barrier.

**#18:** also use bullhorn if necessary.

**#19** base of Cliffs: Call out rocks.

**#21** base of Cliffs: Call out rocks.

Monitor radio for reports from #22 about runners coming down Waterfall.

**#20, #22** above Cliff at junction of Switchback Trail and Cliff route by fencing: Direct runners to their intended route: Switchback, Cliff, or Waterfall. #22 radio to #21 when a racer chooses the Waterfall route.

Keep spectators off the trails.
